Description

The CS Undergraduate Teaching Assistant (UTA) program will provide opportunities for undergraduate students to gain teaching experience while helping improve the learning process of fellow students. Most UTA's will serve as lab and recitation instructors in introductory programming courses, but we also envision additional activities such as presenting review and help sessions for a wide variety of courses and topics.

How to apply:

To apply for a UTA position for next fall, simply ask one of your CS/IT instructors to nominate you. If you have course preferences, let your nominator know of them. A faculty committee will determine who will receive UTA awards and will contact the awardees during the summer.

Minimum Time Commitment:

Most UTA assignments, such as one lab or recitation, will require approximately 4-5 hours a week, which is the minimum commitment you must make. One student may accept up to 3 assignments. You may also combine a UTA assignment with other jobs such as PAC consulting, grading hours, or other part-time employment.
